The USS Kete was lost on 20 March 1945 with 87 men lost. The name of each crew member was read and the bell tolled.

In the absence of Commander Ron Olson, Past Commander John Ludwig began the March 16th Mid-Atlantic Base meeting with recognizing our POWs/MIAs, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to our Flag led by the COB Ed Simpson, and the USSVI Creed read.
